When life takes unexpected turns, the gift of support can make all the difference. CORE: Children of Restaurant Employees, a national non-profit provides financial relief to food and beverage service employees with children when either the parent or child faces a health crisis, illness, injury, a death, or loss of home or place of employment due to a natural disaster.

CORE has provided support to families in all 50 states in the form of a financial grant. The grant may cover rent or mortgage, utilities, medical bills, therapy sessions or equipment, funds for basic necessities, or childcare costs while a family works through one of these crises. Many times, restaurant and beverage service employees may not have a financial safety net in place. Compounded by missing work to navigate one of these specific circumstances can add stress and financial strain. CORE is here to help. They also offer communications tools and a downloadable back of the house poster to post in your restaurant or bar that is in English and Spanish. Employees with children can review grant criteria and apply online. A family can also be referred.
