CORE: Children of Restaurant Employees (@COREgives) serves as a resource for any type of food and beverage service operations employee with children. CORE, a national non-profit dedicated to providing financial relief to F&B operations employees with children when either the parent or their child faces a health crisis, injury, death, or the loss of their home or place of work due to a natural disaster.

Founded by members of the beverage industry who recognized a need and wanted to give back to operations employees with children who serve us every day. Any restaurant or beverage service employee with children in the U.S. may be eligible for support to relieve financial burdens when they face a qualifying circumstance. The grants help cover living expenses that includes rent/mortgage, utilities, medical supplies, prescription costs, therapies, and other essential needs that a family might find necessary to navigate their specific circumstances. Each grant is unique and tailored to meet the applicants needs and documentation is required.
